

Borough of Thompsontown
Council Meeting
January 19, 2026
7 PM

A regular meeting of the Borough of Thompsontown Council was held in the Thompsontown Borough Office at 121 N. Mill St., Thompsontown, PA on December 15, 2025. The following were in attendance Mayor Kenneth Hart, President Roger Stutts, Vice- President Andy Lenig, Secretary-Treasurer Sue Pontius, Councilmen/ Councilwoman: Williard Roush, Martin Wilson, Robert Speece, Nathan Claybaugh, Solicitor Seth Mosebey and Engineer Brian Book. Connie Eaton was absent. Fire Department minutes their meeting is later this week. Municipal Authority meeting notes were not available. Motion to approve the Financial Report was made by Andy Lenig and seconded by Nathan Claybaugh. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Robert Speece and seconded by Willard Roush.

Presidents Stutts went around the room to residents attending, but ones in attendance just came to attend the meeting. Nobody had any issues or questions for Council.

Secretary Pontius reviewed with Council they have five grants sent in for approval. Three small grants, two for the Ambulance and three for the Borough. The Borough grant was sent in to PIRMA for \$5000, the other two were for the Community Building and the Helipad. The one small Ambulance grant has already been approved for \$15,000, questions from the application reviewers have all been sent back. No other questions were sent from any of the other grants. Engineer Book handed out his information on the grants that he had also.

Secretary Pontius gave all Council members the final review report for any changes for the 2025-2026 Budget. No final changes were suggested. A motion to accept the budget for 2025-2026 was made by Willard Roush and Andy Lenig. All of Council approved.

Secretary Pontius sent around the State Budget Report for all of Council to review. The State Budget Report was reviewed with the year ending online report with the actual receipts. Secretary Pontius informed Council these State figures ran about the same each year, unless a grant is done during the year. A motion to approve the State Budget was made by Robert Speece and seconded by Andy Lenig.

President Stutts informed Council members of the Little League were upset with Council approving the removal of the mound. It was suggested to let them know who owns the grounds.

Mayor Hart when he attended a Fire Department meeting, a request for playground equipment for handicapped children came up. She was invited to a Borough meeting since the Borough handles the park. Person was a no-show at tonight's meeting.

Mayor Hart also had the possibility of rental of the church come up, but there was no follow-up at this time.

Meeting adjourned by President Stutts at 0735 PM.
