

Borough of Thompsontown  
Council Meeting  
May 19, 2025  
7 PM

A regular meeting of the Borough of Thompsontown Council was held in the Thompsontown Borough Office at the new location on 121 N. Mill St., Thompsontown, PA on April 21, 2025. The following were in attendance Mayor Kenneth Hart, President Roger Stutts, Secretary-Treasurer Sue Pontius, Councilmen/Councilwoman: Martin Wilson, Williard Roush, Robert Speece, Connie Eaton, Nathan Claybaugh, Solicitor Seth Mosebey and Engineer Brian Book. Vice-President Andy Lenig was absent. Minutes for the Fire Department and the Municipal Authority were not available. Motion to approve the financial report was made by Connie Eaton and seconded by Nathan Claybaugh. Motion to approve the minutes by Willard Roush and seconded by Robert Speece with this one correction: Engineer Brian Book informed everyone that in the fall construction will be on the North side of the community building.

President Stutts started with the visitors around the room. Thompsontown Pack #169 Scout Declan Burger came to the meeting to get his Eagle Scout project approved by Council. He asked to be able to paint the fences, the barb-b-que pit and barb-b-que chicken holders. Motion was made by Connie Eaton to approve this project and seconded by Robert Speece. All of Council approved.

Next, Jessica Guyer Curator, Tuscarora Academy Museum, County Advisor for American 250 PA came to hand out signs for Council members to hold up for a photo.

Jason Walton Fire Chief for the Thompsontown Volunteer Fire Company asked Council permission to put a fire hydrant at the creek by Regester's parking lot. The fire company had asked for permission for this many years ago. Mr. Walton gave Engineer Book information to review. Engineer Book reported to Council once the new pumping station is completed the fire hydrant will have the capacity to pump out 1000 gallons/minute. President Stutts also commented that the new fire truck has been restored and looks impressive.

President Stutts commented Council will be working on advertising for the church rentals in the near future.

Secretary Pontius reviewed the cost of new countertops from Keystone Countertops for in the new office. The estimate was for \$675 plus approximately \$25 for stain and glue to put the desk together. Motion to approve by Martin Wilson and seconded by Nathan Claybaugh. All of Council approved.

President Stutts informed Council Losch Flooring has not signed a new contract yet. He and his wife would like to discuss the five-year contract further, but they did not come to tonight's meeting. Council discussed offering Losch a new three-year contract. President Stutts will discuss the agreement with him.

Secretary Pontius informed Council she received a bill from Dunamis Power & Light at 4:30 pm today. The bill was for corresponding to 30% of the net total amount from December 2024. Motion to pay made by Connie Eaton and seconded by Martin Wilson. All of Council approved.

Councilman Nathan Claybaugh informed Council he was approached about the crosswalks need to be painted again. President Stutts said he will discuss with our workers.
